Sub:- Application dated 28.04.2016 of the Director, H.K.Kalchuri Education Trust, 31, Shyamla Hills, Bharat Bhawan Road, Bhopal-462002 (M.P.) to establish a new Ayurveda college in the name of L.N. Ayurved College & Hospital, Bhopal, J.K. Town, Sarvadharam, C-Sector, Kolar Road, Bhopal with 100 seats in BAMS course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, from the academic session 2017-18- Letter of Permission -regarding.

Sir,

In continuation to the Ministry's letter of even No. dated 21.06.2017 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCIM, in terms of the criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the 'Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016', provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letters No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Director, H.K.Kalchuri Education Trust, 31, Shyamla Hills, Bharat Bhawan Road, Bhopal-462002 (M.P.) to start new Ayurveda College in the name of "L.N. Ayurved College & Hospital, Bhopal, J.K. Town, Sarvadharam, C-Sector, Kolar Road, Bhopal with admission capacity of 100 seats in BAMS course, under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 and regulations made thereunder, from the academic session 2017-18.

2. The college may therefore take admissions for 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2017-18 subject to the condition that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2017 to get conditional permission for the session 2018-19 (a copy of Assessment report of the CCIM is also enclosed):

- (i) all the relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

- (ii) all the relevant requirements under the (Minimum Standard of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.
4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
5. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against above UG course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
6. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
7. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
